Expression of interior states in subconscious symbols

Finnegan's Wake; passages from *Ulysses*, *To the Light-house*, *The Sound and the Fury*

Interior and Confessional poetry

Personal language symbols

Work by Sylvia Plath, Robert Lowell, Theodore Roethke, Ted Hughes, W.B. Yeats, Allan Ginsberg

Psychological realism

Projecting interior states onto exterior images

Works by T.S. Eliot, Franz Kafka, early Eugene O'Neill, drama by Jean Paul Sartre

Hyperrealism

Depiction of realistic images to convey interior states

Gabriel Garcia Marquez; Joyce Carol Oates; Thomas Pynchon, Don DeLillo; cyberpunk

Lyric poetry

Expression of interior states via conventional images and language

Works of Poe; sonnets of Shakespeare and Petrarch; Tennyson; the Browning; most pre-modern work

Memoir

Recitation of personal events and thoughts

Autobiographies (Arnie Dillard, Richard Rodriguez); personal essays (Montaigne, Charles Lamb, E.B. White), travelogues
